Student Union Notes:

1. External Nights impact on fundraiser nights in the Student Lounge
2. The Student Lounge and The Academy is provided for Clubs and Societies to use for the following reasons:
 - 2.1. The Student Lounge and The Academy is a safe place to be
 - 2.2. The Clubs and Societies have ownership of the Student Lounge and The Academy
 - 2.3. The Student Lounge and The Academy is provided purely for the benefit of ARU Students
3. More Clubs and Societies are starting up year on year meaning that allocated grant money does not cover all their expenses; therefore they rely on money from fundraisers that are held in the Student Lounge and The Academy.
4. The Students' Union, including the Student Lounge and The Academy, is a not for profit organisation and any profit that is made is reinvested back into Students' Union activities and ultimately the Clubs and Societies themselves.
5. The Students' Union does not have enough financial resources to support Clubs and Societies to the extent to which we would like to.

The Union Believes:

1. Fundraisers should primarily benefit Clubs and Societies and ARU Students, no benefits to any external organisations or individuals.
2. Advertising and promoting external nights on campus is impacting on attendance at nights in the Student Lounge and The Academy, which are for the primary benefit of Clubs and Societies.

The Union Resolves:

1. No Club or Society Member will advertise or promote any external (NON-SU, for example not club or societies) events on ARU premises.
2. No Club or Society Member will advertise or promote any external (NON-SU, for example not club or societies) events via Social Media.
3. Only ARU Students' Union approved events will be promoted on campus
4. Clubs and Societies should show support for other Clubs and Societies fundraisers
5. Clubs and Societies are not allowed to hold external events on the same night as other Clubs and Societies fundraisers
