Union Notes

- 1. ATOS Healthcare is a French IT company paid by the current government to administer work capability assessments
- 2. 31 of the 123 centres used by ATOS for conducting work capability assessments do not have ground floor access for wheelchair users
- 3. As a result of their unreliable and unethical methods of assessment over 1000 people have died after they had been declared Fit To Work by ATOS
- Their unreliability is further demonstrated in that 40% of appeals to ATOS decisions are successful and a further 70% when there is legal representation involved
- 5. ATOS are coming onto campuses to recruit students to work for them

Union Believes

- 1. That the unreliable methods ATOS use are not acceptable
- 2. That ATOS's conduct and role in disability assessment is concerning, and that it has an impact on the lives of disabled students
- 3. That the recent shakeup of disability benefit will have a real impact on the lives of current and future disabled students

Union Resolves

- 1. That the union should work with NUS Disabled Students Campaign to campaign against ATOS
- 2. That the union should not enter into any partnership with ATOS whether that be them delivering accredited courses or recruiting employers at our University, in such a case the Students' Union will encourage and lobby the university to not invite them onto campus
- 3. That the union should encourage the University to condemn ATOS for their harmful role in disability assessment
