Union Believes:

We acknowledge the legal limits of this freedom in United Kingdom.

We believe that participants who are willing to hear opposing viewpoints and express their own ideas in civil manner will have the greatest diversity of voices and the best chances for real learning.

We believe in treating each other with dignity and acting in ways that promote the safety, freedom, and well-being of others.

ARU Students' Union considers it is illegal to attack or threaten people's property as well as to encourage or incite others to do so

ARU Students' union recognises that we must abide by the government's Prevent legislation which helps prevent people from becoming drawn into terrorism.

ARU Students' Union believes it is unacceptable to hold an entire group of people accountable for real or imagined wrongdoing committed by a subgroup.

Finally, we believe that appreciating the benefits of difference of opinions adds the value of being tolerant and patient towards others.

To create an environment where students will be able to comfortably talk about sensitive topics without causing anyone any harm emotionally or physically.
