Introducing audio recordings for lectures with little/no visual aids.

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Union Notes

- 1. Students have different learning styles/needs.
- 2. Lectures with no visual aids make note-taking virtually impossible to get all the necessary information down.

Union Believes

- 1. Students should have the right to access any required extra learning resources.
- 2. By making recordings of lectures available, it can only improve students' learning experience.
- 3. This will not be detrimental to students attending lectures; it will only be used as a device to refer back to.
- 4. This should be in place for lectures with little to no visual aids available.
- 5. Recordings should be uploaded to the VLE as soon as possible, but by the time of the next lecture at the very latest.

Union Resolves

- 1. Actively encourage university staff, where necessary, to make recordings of lectures available.
- 2. To speak to Course Reps on various courses to find out if this is already taking place, and where there is a need for it.
- 3. For the Students' Union to regularly feedback on progress of this being implemented.
