Union Believes

1. Students should have the right to access any required extra learning resources.

3. This will not be detrimental to students attending lectures; it will only be used as a device to refer back to.
4. This should be in place for lectures with little to no visual aids available.
5. Recordings should be uploaded to the VLE as soon as possible, but by the time of the next lecture at the very latest.

Union Resolves

1. Actively encourage university staff, where necessary, to make recordings of lectures available.
2. To speak to Course Reps on various courses to find out if this is already taking place, and where there is a need for it.
3. For the Students' Union to regularly feedback on progress of this being implemented.
