Union Notes

1. Anglia Ruskin has a wide range of societies.

Union Believes

- 1. Due to the high amount of societies presented to them at once, students will often judge a society by name alone.
- 2. An irrelevant/misleading name could be very confusing for new students, which may lead to them paying to join societies they have no interest in.
- 3. Relevant names would usually indicate the interests, campaigns, or organisations that the society has a focus on.
- 4. Irrelevant names would mean names that are not indicative of, or misleading about, the interests, campaigns, or organisations that the society has a focus on.

Union Resolves

- 1. To avoid confusion, societies should have names that are easily recognisable as to what interests, campaigns, or organisations that the society has a focus on.
- 2. To provide guidelines on what constitutes a 'relevant name' in appropriate handbooks and start up packs for societies and clubs.
