## **Union Notes:**

- 1. Anglia Ruskin is a university that tries to support its students in every area possible
- 2. There is often a large gap between University & Private rented sector accommodation prices and student loan amounts
- 3. Higher fees alone have led to 17% decrease in students progressing to university (BBC)
- 4. Student's studying in Cambridge don't get the extra help that London students get, despite being in one of the most expensive cities in the country to live in
- 5. International students don't get a maintenance loan and are also limited in the hours they can work whilst studying to support themselves financially.

## Union Believes:

- 1. If students can't afford university accommodation, dropout rates will increase
- 2. Money worries often cause stress by impacting on physical and mental health, which effects wellbeing and student's education
- 3. With the government's decision to cut grants and introduce loans, prospective students have to take into account extra debt. Students already us 150% of these loans to pay for accommodation (NUS)

## Union Resolves:

- 1. To run a campaign to look into support for International students seeking accommodation
- 2. To work with the local councils on ensuing Admin fees & other fees related to accommodation are all fair and legal within the Private Rented sector
