Role Description

As a PGR Rep your responsibilities are:

- To proactively seek out feedback from PGR students across your faculty.
- To present student concerns and feedback to appropriate departments and members of staff, including signposting students to support services.
- To attend and report to Faculty Partnership meetings.
- To attend and lead PGR Forums.
- To attend PGR Rep training with the Students' Union.
- To communicate with PGR students in your faculty on a regular basis.

Alongside these responsibilities, you will have the opportunity to:

- Get involved with Students' Union campaigns and activities.
- Log volunteering hours and skills on your Volunteer Profile.
- Sit on panels and meetings within ARU to improve academic achievement and help make decisions on behalf of students.
- Develop skills and attributes that will benefit your personal and professional development.

Time Commitment

Being an effective representative should take approximately 15 hours per trimester. This includes attending training, attending meetings, and consulting with and reporting back to the students that you represent.
